9. Sporting Aims and Achievements

The school takes part in numerous sporting activities throughout the year including football, rugby, athletics, netball and basketball.

During lockdown a range of online physical activities were promoted. In June we had a virtual Sports' Week ending with a Sports Day linked with Cardiff City FC. Fit4Fun Coaching Services run afternoon sessions during the school day and

after school club. The afternoon sessions have resumed however the after school club sessions have been delayed until further notice.

10. Healthy Eating

Healthy Eating is promoted throughout the school. Healthy eating and drinking and keeping mentally fit and healthy are all part of our programmes. The school has been awarded its fourth healthy school's leaf. A programme of Health Education is taught throughout the school as part of the curriculum. Health visitors, dentists, doctors and nurses may visit the school to give talks, demonstrations or show videos.
